



Two Together is a non profit, after-school literacy program for elementary school children, grades 1 through 6 in Albany's South End. Daily tutoring sessions are held. Tutoring sessions are held daily from 3:00 – 4:30 pm. Tutors provide one on one reading, writing and homework help to students in one of Albany's most disadvantaged neighborhoods.

University of Albany student volunteers are needed to serve as one-on-one tutors to children in the Two Together program. Some volunteer time may also be spent in library operations and other support activities in order to complete required EDU 390 hours. On-going training will be provided to give volunteer tutors the skills and materials needed to help children improve their literacy, reading and writing skills. Training hours are counted as service hours. Elementary school teachers act as site coordinators to provide guidance during all tutoring sessions.

Two Together administrators have read the EDU 390 course syllabus, understand the requirements and are prepared to provide you with a meaningful experience that you will reflect on not only for this class but perhaps for the rest of your life. Join us at Two Together and gain the satisfaction of making a direct difference in a child's life.

Tutoring sessions are held at Two Together Headquarters in the South End of Albany at 200 Green Street. Two Together is accessible via CDTA Bus Route 12 (Downtown) with a transfer to CDTA Bus Route 8 (Mount Hope). On-street parking is available for students with vehicles. Two Together is accessible to those with disabilities.
